This is, hereby, to inform you that it is **mandatory** for all CCS students of **Grade 6** to appear in **Cambridge Primary Checkpoints** for the subjects of **Science, Mathematics** and **English** during the Academic Session 2023-24 against the following the course codes:

**Primary Science: 0097**

**Primary Mathematics: 0096**

**Primary English: 0057**

Similarly, it is **mandatory** for all CCS students of **Grade 8** to appear in **Cambridge Lower Secondary Checkpoints** for the subjects of **Science, Mathematics** and **English** during the Academic Session 2023-24 against the following the course codes:

**Lower Secondary Science: 0893**

**Lower Secondary Mathematics: 0862**

**Lower Secondary English: 0876**

There is a **Cambridge Checkpoint course code** for each subject that is assigned to a list of learning objectives (topics to be covered) for appearing in the Checkpoint Exams. These course codes have already been mentioned in all academic documents published and provided to students so far, including Checkpoint booklets (compiled checkpoint past papers), Exam syllabus outlines as well as lesson PowerPoint Presentations.

The school curriculum framework for grade 6 and grade 8 is based on the list of learning objectives provided by the Cambridge team for each of the aforementioned subjects.
